Background Information

HCGA manages two well established, successful community garden sites that are situated approximately 10 minutes walk from each other in Shepherd's Bush. In addition we run a propagation project in glasshouses in the local park. The Association is currently looking to appoint 2 new team members.

Community Gardener 3 days per week £14,754 NJC Scale6 pt 26

The successful applicant will be expected to help maintain the sites and work to encourage volunteers become more involved in the projects particularly those use from hard to reach groups. The Association runs a series of events, and summer play scheme activities to which the community gardener will be expected to contribute. The Association also has strong links with other local organisations in the area that use the gardens for a variety of project work.

Schools Gardener 2 days per week £9,836 NJC Scale 6 pt26

The successful applicant will run gardening activities based in local primary schools during term time. The Association runs a series of events, and play scheme activities to which the post holder will be expected to contribute.

For a suitable candidate the trustees would consider combining the posts to make a full time appointment

The successful applicants will require an Enhance Criminal Records Bureau Check

The Association is committed to local participation and promoting sustainable use of resources.

Short listed candidates will be encouraged to visit the gardens before the interview.
